<b>DURATION</b>	20 minutes
<b>OBJECTIVES</b>	Main: Taking Initiative  Others: Creativity
<b>MATERIALS</b>	No specific materials are required for this activity
<b>LEARNING ACTIVITY METHOD</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The teacher explains the topic by means of the visuals</li> <li>• The students are encouraged to think of a goal they would like to reach by the end of the scholastic year</li> <li>• In turn, each student says out his goal and the rest of the class gives an example of how they would perform in order to reach the goal</li> <li>• The student will then say whether the suggestions given were considered by himself to reach his goal</li> <li>• All the children take turns at saying their goal and at hearing possible ways of being successful</li> </ul> <p>The goals can be divided into categories so that students are split into groups. In this way the activity can be used to also enhance the skill of teamwork.</p> <p><i>*Examples of goals for teachers to start off the discussion could include:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <i>Being kinder to my classmates</i></li> <li>- <i>Doing well in completing school tasks</i></li> <li>- <i>Sharing more in class</i></li> <li>- <i>Trying harder to get better grades</i></li> </ul>
